Medicare Patients

MEDICARE – Medicare recipients can obtain Afrezza® for a copay of no more than \$35 a month for covered prescriptions. There will be no deductible or coverage gap applied (i.e. donut hole*) for covered insulin products. Coverage may require a prior authorization for Afrezza.

Indications and Limitations of Use

Afrezza® (insulin human) Inhalation Powder is a man-made rapid acting insulin breathed in through your lungs (inhaled) and is used to control high blood sugar in adult patients with diabetes mellitus. AFREZZA is available by prescription only.

- AFREZZA is a man-made insulin that is breathed-in through your lungs (inhaled) and is used to control high blood sugar in adults with diabetes mellitus.
- AFREZZA is not for use to treat diabetic ketoacidosis. AFREZZA must be used with basal insulin in people who have type 1 diabetes mellitus.
- It is not known if AFREZZA is safe and effective for use in people who smoke. AFREZZA is not for use in people who smoke or have recently stopped smoking (less than 6 months).
- It is not known if AFREZZA is safe and effective in children under 18 years of age.

Important Safety Information

AFREZZA can cause serious side effects including:

- **Sudden lung problems (bronchospasms).** Do not use AFREZZA if you have long-term (chronic) lung problems such as asthma or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD). Before starting AFREZZA, your healthcare provider will give you a breathing test to check how your lungs are working.

HOW TO USE YOUR CARD

When you have completed enrollment online, **present the Afrezza® Savings Card confirmation email or confirmation page to the pharmacist** along with your insurance card and prescription.

Afrezza is available at your local neighborhood retail pharmacy, as well as specialty or mail order pharmacies, which ship Afrezza directly to your home.

*This program is for commercially insured patients and requires a valid prescription for Afrezza. Important Safety Information Continued

Tell your healthcare provider if you:

- Have lung problems such as asthma or COPD
- Have or have had lung cancer
- Are using any inhaled medications
- Smoke or have recently stopped smoking
- Have kidney or liver problems
- Are pregnant, planning to become pregnant, or are breastfeeding. AFREZZA may harm your unborn or breastfeeding baby.
- Are taking any other medications, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, or herbal supplements

Before you start using AFREZZA, talk to your healthcare provider about low blood sugar and how to manage it.

The most common side effects of AFREZZA are low blood sugar (hypoglycemia), cough, and sore throat. These are not all the possible side effects of AFREZZA. Call your healthcare provider for medical advice about side effects.
